All candidates who participated in the Post-UTME Screening Exercise for admission into the Rivers State University for 2025/2026 Academic Session but did not meet the weighted average for admission into the programmes of their choice may now apply for ***supplementary admission on satisfaction of the following:-***

- (1) Candidates must possess correct subject combination in the Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) for the advertised programmes.
- (2) Candidates must possess the basic five (5) O' level credit passes including English Language and Mathematics in accordance with the University's Entry Requirements (Faculty/Departmental).
- (3) Candidates are expected to log onto the University Website [www.rsu.edu.ng](http://www.rsu.edu.ng) and make e-payments of **Fifteen Thousand Naira (N15,000.00)** only by **generating a transaction id** on the University Website for the fee and proceed to any of the designated Banks to pay using the **Pay Direct Bank** option or using **Interswitch Verve enabled cards**.
